Islam forbids women to get married without a Wali (Guardian). A marriage without a Wali is invalid. Anyone who wishes to get married at LIC must have a Wali. LIC has designated Imam Sabir to be Wali for revert sisters only.

Any revert sisters who wishes to have Imam Sabir as their Wali must fill in the form below and hand it in the main LIC reception desk.

Under LIC Waliship, no meetings or discussions between the prospective bride and groom should be made without the prior permission of the Wali.

The Wali will have the right to have the final say on the marriage.
