

Terms and Conditions

1. Islam forbids women to get married without a Wali (Guardian). A marriage without a Wali is invalid. Anyone who wishes to get married at LIC must have a Wali. **(Note: The Legal Sharia guardian (Wali) must be in the following order of priority: The father, the paternal grandfather, the full brother, the bride's son, and so on. It is mandatory that all of them are adult male Muslims.)**
2. For revert sisters & sisters without a Wali who wishes to have one of the LIC Imams to act as her Wali must fill in the form below and hand in the completed form, along with their I.D., to the main LIC reception desk.
3. It is mandatory for the Imam to have a meeting with the applicant before agreeing to be the wali. This includes meeting with the potential spouse.
4. Please take note, this form does not guarantee that the Imam will be the Wali and the Imam, at his discretion, has the right to decline the waliship form.
5. Under LIC Waliship, no meetings or discussions between the prospective bride and groom should be made without the prior permission of the Wali.
6. The Imam will have the right to have the final say on the marriage and nullify the marriage if required (Marriage annulment).
7. The Imam will have the right to add conditions to your nikah certificate.
